# Chapter 1 Introduction

## What is the Sitelok Turnstile plugin?

Sitelok's built in CAPTCHA system is suitable for most sites but if you prefer to use the commonly used Cloudflare Turnstile system instead then this plugin will allow that.



# Chapter 2 Installation

## Signup for Turnstile

Turnstile is a free service from Cloudflare. You need to create a Cloudflare account to have access to Turnstile. The free level is fine. You can signup here if you don't already have a Cloudflare account.

**Do not install the plugin until you have the required keys from your Cloudflare account ready to enter into the plugin.**

**If you have previously installed the Google reCaptcha plugin you must disable that first. Only one third party captcha plugin can be installed and enabled.**

The first step is to create a Turnstile Widget in your Cloudflare account so that we can generate the necessary public and secret keys required.

- 1) Click Turnstile in the main menu.
- 2) Click the Add Widget button and name the widget as you wish.
- 3) Add your domain name. For example [yoursite.com](#)
- 4) Set the rest of the settings as in the screenshot on the next page.

### Widget Mode

**Managed**

Cloudflare will use information from the visitor to decide if an interactive challenge should be used. If we do show an interaction, the user will be prompted to check a box (no images or text to decipher).

**Non-interactive**

A purely non-interactive challenge. Users will see a widget with a loading bar while the browser challenge is run.

**Invisible**

Invisible challenge that does not require interaction.

### Would you like to opt for pre-clearance for this site?

You can opt to let your Turnstile widget issue a clearance cookie, as if the user had passed a challenge on your Cloudflare proxied website. The cookie will be valid for the challenge passage time specified [in your website's security settings](#)

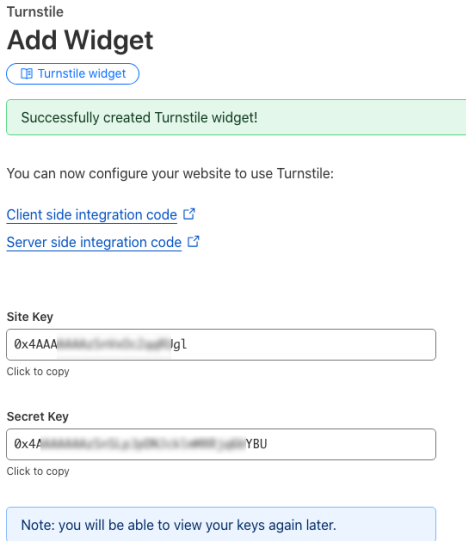

- 5) Click the Create button to make the widget.
- 6) You will now be show the required public and secret keys required by the plugin.



## Installing for the first time or upgrading

Please note that once you install the plugin then enabling CAPTCHA in the Sitelok configuration page will use Turnstile for verification instead of the default built in system.

- 1) Extract the contents of the zip file to your PC.
- 2) Upload the **plugin\_turnstile** folder to your existing Sitelok slpw folder using FTP. There are no special permissions required on most servers.
- 3) Login to the Sitelok control panel.
- 4) Open the following URL in the browser

which will start the installation process. If all is well you will be taken to the plugin preferences page where you will see the plugin listed.

If you have any problems with installation please let us know so that we can help you.

## Disabling the Plugin

To disable the Turnstileplugin select **Plugin Preferences** in the **Plugin** menu option of Sitelok. Uncheck the enable box for the plugin and click the **Save** button. You can enable it again in the same way.

## Uninstalling the plugin

To permanently remove the plugin and its settings follow these steps.


- 1) Disable the plugin as above.
- 2) Click the delete icon next the plugin in the disabled plugins section.
- 3) Confirm the action in the alert box.

If the plugin is uninstalled successfully you will be returned to the plugin preferences page.



# Chapter 3 Using the plugin

Click the Turnstile option in the Plugins menu to display the settings page.

## Site key

Enter the Site key string obtained from Cloudflare.

## Secret key

Enter the Secret key string obtained from Cloudflare.

## Size

Select either normal, flexible or compact.

Click [Save changes](#).

## Adding to Sitelok forms

Please note that the form designers in Sitelok support Turnstile but will show the default captcha system on the designer page. This will be replaced when you generate the form.

### Default login form

The default login form will automatically display the Turnstile box once you setup the plugin and enable **Login Captcha** in **Tools - Configuration - General**.

### Login forms

In the form designer you need to check the **Include Captcha** field and also make sure **Login Captcha** is enabled in **Tools - Configuration - General**.

### Registration forms

In the form designer you need to add the captcha field to the form and also make sure **Registration Captcha** is enabled in **Tools - Configuration - General**.

### Contact forms

In the form designer you just need to add the captcha field to the form.
