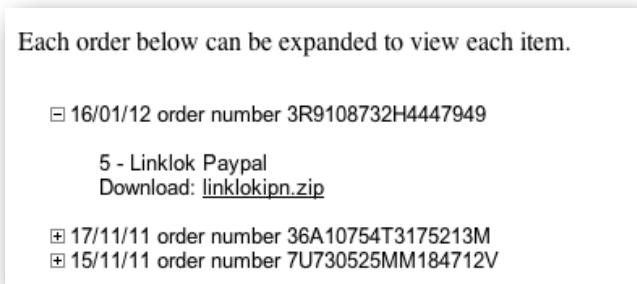

Chapter 1 Introduction

What is the Sitelok Linklok Orders plugin?

The Sitelok Linklok Orders plugin is an add on for Sitelok and Linklok Paypal, Linklok Mals or Linklok ASecurecart that allows you to setup an automated download area for your clients. Every order handled by Linklok will create an account in Sitelok for the user (or update an existing account) allowing them to login and access downloads whenever they wish. You can decide for how long orders are available for access to clients. For example you may wish them to only access downloads for 30 days or provide permanent access. Alternatively you may decide to simply use the system to allow you access to resend download links manually rather than allowing users to login themselves. Either way it is a useful addition which does not affect other users on Sitelok.



You can use this plugin even if you already have Linklok adding users to Sitelok.

Other Linklok generated data such serial numbers ect are also supported by the plugin and will be available for users.

Chapter 2 Installation

Installing for the first time or upgrading

- 1) Extract the contents of the zip file to your PC.
- 2) Upload the plugin_linklokorders folder to your existing Sitelok slpw folder using FTP. There are no special permissions required on most servers.
- 3) Login to the Sitelok control panel.
- 4) Open the following URL in the browser

http://www.yoursite.com/slpw/plugin_linklokorders/install.php

which will start the installation process. If all is well you will be taken to the plugin preferences page where you will see the plugin listed.

If you have any problems with installation please let us know so that we can help you.

Setting up Linklok to call Sitelok

Before Linklok can create users in Sitelok we need to enable the connection. To do this open up your Linklok file (linklokipn.php for Paypal, linklokasc.php for ASecurecart or linkkokme.php for Mals) and add the following anywhere near your other settings.

For Linklok Paypal (see below for other versions)

and upload the updated file to your server.

Setting up the plugin

If you are using an older version of Sitelok prior to V5 the screenshots will differ.


- 1) Upload the email template **linklokorder.htm** (from the examples folder in the zip) to the **slpw/email** folder on your server.
- 2) Login to the Sitelok admin and go to **Plugins - Linklok Orders**.

Expiry time for emailed links

Expiry time for links emailed to the user (from when email is sent)

Set the number of days since an order you want the links to be available for users. Set 0 to provide access to all orders no matter how old.

Select the email template to use if you resend the links to the user. The example linklokorder.htm is a good starting point.

Set the time that emailed links should be valid for.

Save the settings.

Disabling the Plugin

To disable the Linklok Orders plugin select **Plugin Preferences** in the **Plugin** menu option of Sitelok. Uncheck the enable box for the plugin and click the **Save** button. You can enable it again in the same way.

Uninstalling the plugin



To permanently remove the plugin and its settings follow these steps.

- 1) Disable the plugin as above.
- 2) Click the delete icon next the plugin in the disabled plugins section.
- 3) Confirm the action in the alert box.

If the plugin is uninstalled successfully you will be returned to the plugin preferences page.

Chapter 3 Using the plugin

Accessing orders in the admin

So far we have setup Linklok to call Sitelok for each order so you should start to see your clients added to Sitelok. In the Sitelok admin you will notice a small cart icon  next to each user. If you click this you will see a list of orders that this users has made. You can click the  icon to expand the order and see each downloadable item.

You can delete an order or any item if required (perhaps because you have refunded).

If you click the **Email** button for any order then the links will be emailed to the user. This uses the email template you set in the plugin options (linklokorder.htm is an example). This email can use the following Sitelok email variables in addition to the standard ones.

!!!linklokordernumber!!! Inserts the relevant order number

!!!linklokitems!!! Will insert the download links for this order.

Moving order to another user

If you wish to move the orders to another user enter the username and click **Move**.

If you need to add orders to a user manually you can use the manual order form in Linklok to do this. Make sure you enter the users email address **and** name.

Searching for an order

You can search for an order by going to **Plugins - Linklok Orders** and entering the order number in to the **Order number** field of the plugin page. If you leave the field blank the last 10 orders will be displayed.

Selecting users who have purchase specific products

There maybe times when you want to select users who have purchased a certain item, so that you can email them for example. To do this go to **Plugins - Linklok Orders** and enter the Linklok product id in the **Product ID** field. If you want to only find purchases within a date range you can enter a **from date** and / or a **to date**. When you click **Select** all users who have

purchased the item will be selected. By default any existing users that are selected will be deselected first. However if you prefer you can select the **Keep Selected** option so that existing selected users remain selected. This is useful if you want to select users who have purchased different items.

If you wish to select users who have purchased a combination of product enter each product od separated by a comma. Users who have purchased ALL of those items will be selected.

Export orders

You can export a list of orders processed (only downloads handled by Linklok). You can set a from and to dates as needed or leave blank. The .csv format file contains the following columns

date
order number
product id
product description
Sitelok buyers name
Sitelok buyers email

No pricing or quantity details are provided though.

Chapter 4 User download page

You can use the plugin just for you own access to orders etc if you wish. However you will probably also want to allow your users to access their own downloads as well. To do this upload the included example download page called mydownloads.php (in the examples folder of the zip) to the root of your site. This is just a simple example but it allows users to login, retrieve a forgotten password and access their downloads.

The download links are processed via Linklok as usual using the original expiry period (updated of course) and other options.

Using your own page

If you want to design your own page you can either modify the example mydownloads.php or create your own. Just make a Sitelok members page in the normal way and

- 1) Secure it for access to the special usergroup **ORDERACCESS**.
- 2) require_once the file `/slpw/plugin_linklokorders/linklokorders.php`
- 3) Load the javascript file `linklokorders.js` and CSS file `linklokorders.css`.
These are both in the `slpw/plugin_linklokorders` folder.
- 4) Add this line in the page where you want the orders to appear.

Letting users know their login details

Of course it makes sense to automatically include a users login details in the download page and email templates that you use in Linklok. To do this you will need to use custom templates. Just add a link to the mydownloads.php page on your site and display the username and password using `!!!sitelokusername!!!` and `!!!sitelokpassword!!!` template

variables. We have included example templates in the examples folder in the zip. To use them just upload emailtemplate.html and returntemplate.html to the same place as Linklok and set

Here is an example template.

By default **!!!sitelokpassword!!!** will always show the password. However for extra security or where you have set Sitelok to use hashed passwords you may prefer to have the password shown only when the Sitelok account is created. Further orders would just show ***** or other text. To set this add this setting to to your linklok fle (linklookipn.php for example).

```
$SitelokHideExistingPassword="*****";
```

You can change the ***** for other text such as your existing password for example.
