Chapter 1 Introduction

What is the Sitelok Website Toolbox plugin?

The Sitelok Website Toolbox plugin allows a single sign-on (SSO) between Sitelok and your Website Toolbox forum. In other words Sitelok will be the login system used by the forum so a user only needs to enter their Sitelok login details to have access to the forum as well.

Chapter 2 Installation

Installing for the first time or upgrading

- 1) Extract the contents of the zip file to your PC.
- 2) Upload the plugin_wtb folder to your existing Sitelok slpw folder using FTP. There are no special permissions required on most servers.
- 3) Login to the Sitelok control panel.
- 4) Open the following URL in the browser

http://www.yoursite.com/slpw/plugin_wtb/install.php

which will start the installation process. If all is well you will be taken to the plugin preferences page where you will see the plugin listed.

If you have any problems with installation please let us know so that we can help you.

Setting up Website Toolbox to work with SSO

Before the forum will allow Sitelok to login in users we need to enable Single Sign-On. To do this.

- 1) Login to <http://www.websitetoolbox.com> and go to **Settings - Single Sign On**
- 2) Click the button to generate an API Key. Copy this key to the clipboard as we will need it later.
- 3) In the **Logout page** field enter this URL (using your domain of course)

- 4) If you wish you can also enter URL's to point to your **Login Page** and **Registration Page**. These are optional though.
- 5) Click **Save**.

Setting up the plugin

Now that Website Tool box has been setup we need to make some settings in the Sitelok plugin. You can access the plugin configuration by selecting [Website Toolbox](#) from the [Plugins](#) menu.

 **Website Toolbox**

Logout of forum as well as Sitelok

1) Set Host to

[USERNAME.websitetoolbox.com](#)

replacing USERNAME with your account username. If you have purchased a managed domain name or you are using a custom domain name for your forum, use that domain name instead.

- 2) Enter the API Key generated when you set Single Sign On in your Website Toolbox account.
- 3) Check the box if you want users to be logged out of the forum if they logout of Sitelok.
- 4) Click the **Save** button.

Disabling the Plugin

To disable the Vanilla plugin select **Plugin Preferences** in the **Plugin** menu option of Sitelok. Uncheck the enable box for the plugin and click the **Save** button. Remember to disable the Single Signon in Website Toolbox as well.

You can enable it again in the same way.

Uninstalling the plugin

To permanently remove the plugin and its settings follow these steps.

- 1) Disable the plugin as above.
- 2) Click the delete icon next the plugin in the disabled plugins section.
- 3) Confirm the action in the alert box.

If the plugin is uninstalled successfully you will be returned to the plugin preferences page.

Chapter 3 In use

Once setup when a user logs in to Sitelok they should be automatically logged into the Website Toolbox forum. The first time the user logs in Website Toolbox will create an account with the same username, email and name. If you have installed the Blab Messaging and Profile plugin then the nickname will be used as the username in the forum and the users profile image will be shared as well.
